Music Venue FAQs

How old do I have to be to attend a show at Lafayette Brewing?

All attendees must be at least 21 years of age to attend events at our facility. Sorry, no exceptions.

Does your venue have reserved seating?

No, all shows at Lafayette Brewing Co. are general admission events with first-come, first-serve for tables and seating. No reservations will be accepted for live music or comedy events.

Can I purchase advance tickets for events?

Yes and no! Advance tickets are available when specified on the show listing. If advance tickets are available, our web page listing & posters will typically include: "Tickets \$\$ adv/\$\$\$ day of show". Otherwise, the event listing will include a cover charge which indicates that tickets are only available at the entrance to the event. Advance tickets can always be purchased here at Lafayette Brewing, and in some cases like Friends of Bob shows, may be available at other select outlets around the Greater Lafayette area. We accept Cash, Visa, Mastercard, Discover and American Express. We especially like cash!

Can I purchase advance tickets (when available) via phone?

Yes, we can be reached at 765-742-2591. Please note, there is a \$1 per ticket handling fee for phone orders. See above for acceptable methods of payment.

Are advance tickets available for on-line purchase?

No, we do not currently offer on-line ticket sales.

Will my advance tickets be mailed to me?

No, all advance tickets purchased via the phone will be held for "will call" pick-up at the entrance to the event. No tickets will be mailed out.

Can I get my money back if I can't attend an event when I bought an advance ticket?

No, there are no refunds or exchanges on advance ticket purchases. Refunds will only be issued if the artist cancels the event.

What time do doors open prior to a show?

For shows starting at 9 pm or later, doors will open 2 hours prior to show time. For shows starting earlier than 9 pm, doors will open 1 hour prior to show time.

Can I pay cover charge or purchase tickets at the door with a credit or debit card?

No, admission must be paid with CASH only at the entrance to an event. Only advance tickets may be purchased with credit or debit cards.

Is there food available in the music venue?

Yes, we have a small kitchen serving appetizers and pizzas. Food can also be ordered “to go” at the 1st floor bar and brought up to our 2nd floor venue.

Can I bring in food or drink from an outside source?

No, all products consumed at Lafayette Brewing Co. must be purchased in house.

What is the capacity of your venue?

According to fire code, our venue occupancy is rated for 340 persons. There may be some events in which the room set-up precludes us from selling the maximum amount of tickets. Please note: While our occupancy is rated for 340, there is NOT seating from 340. Typically, we have seating for approximately 130 persons. We will occasionally bring in additional seating when warranted.

Is smoking allowed in your venue?

No, Lafayette City ordinance requires that we maintain a smoke-free environment. Smoking is not permitted anywhere in our facility.

What type of beverages are available in your music venue?

In addition to our line-up of award-winning, house brewed ales and lagers, we also offer a limited selection of quality spirits and mixers along with a selection of quality wines from our 2nd floor bar. Blended cocktails and liqueurs are not available.

Can we play pool, foosball and darts during a live music show?

Access to the dart boards is closed during all music events. Access to the pool and foosball tables is determined by the production company. Generally for Friends of Bob shows, the gaming tables are not accessible. For most other shows, they are available.

Can I lease the 2nd floor for a private function?
